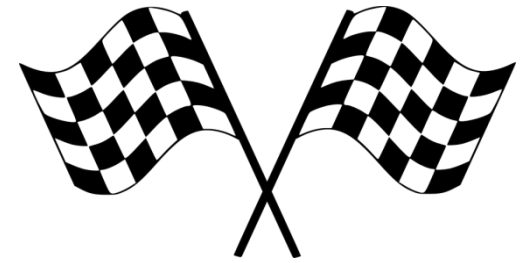

Guiding Principles for Ministry Volunteers at RR

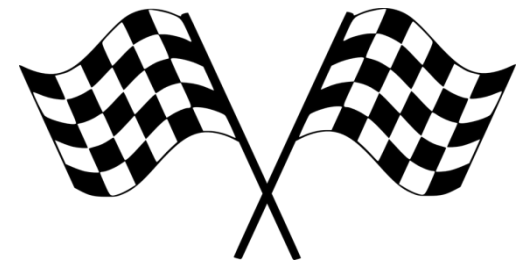
- We are and shall behave with a Christ-like attitude, uplifting, encouraging and being respectful of all guests.
- We are here to serve the fans by offering them loving ministry through hospitality and witness in the name of Christ.
- We are the guests of Richmond Raceway and should respect management's guidelines at all times, and be flexible and willing to help in all areas needed.
- We are not to offer any material other than that approved and provided by CVRM. The material is to only be distributed at our sites.
- We are not to do aggressive evangelism, but to be sensitive to fans' spiritual needs as we meet other needs. If a fan is open to your witness, please do share what Jesus Christ is doing in your life and can do in their life. There are tracts and Bibles to assist you in sharing the Good News.
- We are to treat others as we'd want to be treated; that includes other CVRM team members as well as fans and employees of RR.

Guidelines for Ministry Volunteers at RR

- Please be faithful in your service, arrive on time, make sure there is coverage at the site before taking a break, and leave only when there are others to take your place.
- Please wear your CVRM identification when on duty so people will know who you are and see you are there to help them.
- Familiarize yourself with RR information, such as locations of restrooms, gates, guest service tents, and vendors, so you can offer helpful information to the fans.
- In case of an emergency, contact CVRM leads, Debbie Carter, Debbie Austin or Charles Ward, so they can respond.
- This opportunity to minister at RR has eternal consequences to those who don't know Jesus Christ. As you serve, pray for those you meet and serve.
- Thank you so much for giving of your time; know that your service is appreciated. Let's have a great time at the races.



Volunteer Needs



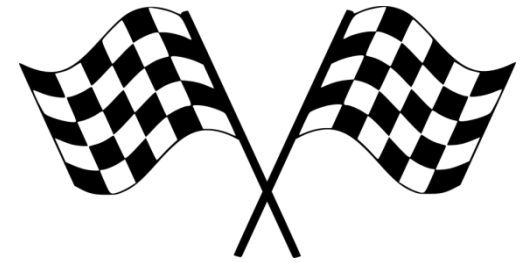
Volunteers are needed to work a 4 to 6 hour shift or all day if you like, to serve in a variety of ways.

As ambassadors of goodwill, opportunities for service include:

- distributing “cups of cold water,” cookies, and Christian driver literature;
- performing as singers or musical groups,
- serving as chaplains and crisis counselors,
- working with the Kids corner,
- driving golf carts
- or as logistics and support persons.

Volunteers are needed for

- **Friday, March 29:** SET-UP Main Hospitality Site & Hospitality Site in F lot.
 - 1 Shift: Noon-3 pm
- **Saturday, March 30, 8:30 am – 1:30 pm**
 - 1st Shift 8:30 – 1:30– cleanup and secure site after race starts
 - 2nd Shift 1:30 - ? Lost and lonely – until race is over
- **Sunday, March 31, 1:00 pm – 7:00 pm**
 - 1st Shift 1:00 – 4:00
 - 2nd Shift 4: 00 – 7:30 tear down site
 - Lost and lonely – until race is over

Jobs for Volunteers



Our location is in a high visibility area with a lot of foot traffic. This is a fun location. More volunteers are needed just to be present and welcome the fans.


- **Main Tent** — Your job is to greet the race fans and offer them cold water and lemonade. A friendly face and a warm welcome is all you need. We can use as many people for this job as show up, but please sign up to make sure we have enough workers.
- **Kids Corner** — Your job is to help setup the Kids corner, greet guests, run the games, and at the end of the day, cleanup and put everything away. The most important job is to greet each child and their family, and make them feel welcome at the site. You should walk them to the games and offer help when needed.

Additional Jobs for Volunteers

- **Guest Services** - Your job is to greet fans at the guest services tent and to provide information about the track. If there are questions you do not know the answers to, simply call our contact person and they will help you. Always answer their questions even if you need to call for more help. There will be two people assigned to each Guest Services tent. You will always be partnered with someone who has worked Guest Services before and help will be provided when needed.
- **Chaplains** - Chaplains are needed at all times during race weekend. Debbie Carter coordinates the chaplains schedule. Please contact her for information and training to be a chaplain at the track. This job provides a great opportunity for us to minister at the track. Our services in this area are greatly appreciated.
- **Cart Drivers** - Cart drivers are needed to transport guests and supplies around the track. We also provide drivers for the Torque Club guests. One or two drivers per shift are needed to carry guests from the Torque parking lot to their entrance gate. Training is required to be a cart driver. There is an opportunity to be trained at each race.

Site Locations

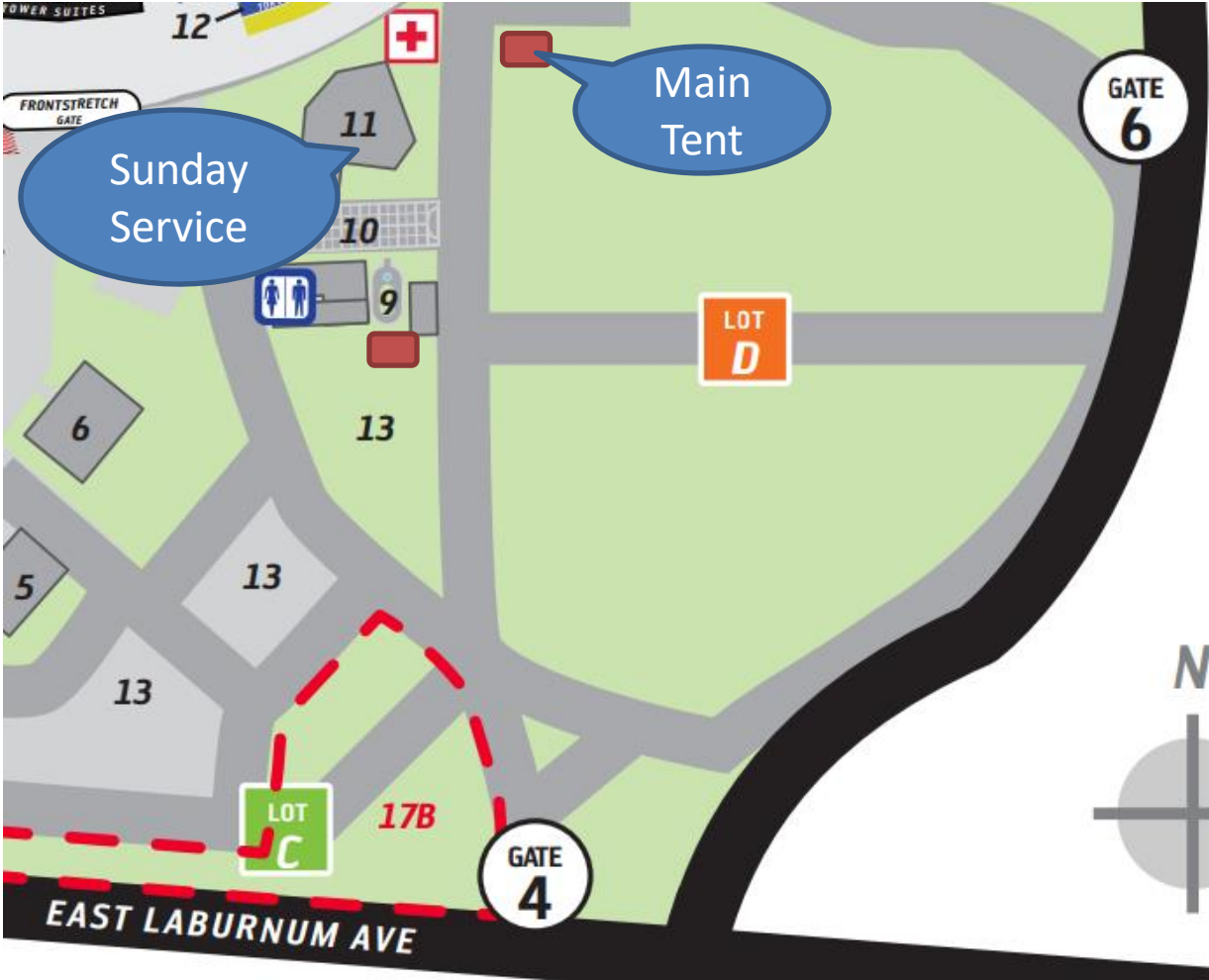
- The **Main site** is located in the parking lot across from the Care Center  outside of Gate 40. This is a great location to greet race fans.
- The **Workers Tent** site and **parking** are located at the end of F lot. Enter through Gate 7 off of Caroline Ave.

Parking

- Parking will be at the Worker Tent. Enter through Gate 7 off of Caroline Ave., at the stop sign turn left, continue on until you see the Disaster Relief Trailer.
