a young Christian (both physically and spiritually) set off to Jamaica with his pastor and a group of men from his church. For a week in the beating down sun upon the Blue Mountain Range of Jamaica, the team joined other Southern Baptist churches to repair buildings and replace roofs that had blown off churches and parsonages following the devasting effects of Hurricane Gilbert. Often at night the men slept on church pews peering up where ceilings once sheltered the sanctuary, and into God's matchless Heavens and endless stars before drifting off.

The young Christian and first-time short-term missionary received a crash course and got his first taste of international missions, disaster relief and youth ministry, as God provided opportunities to serve with what this young man saw as his limited talent and abilities. Over the decades, God would open more doors and place a call on his life.

Missions are often the door that opens the eyes of seekers and young believers to God's call on their lives. Missions often reinvigorate the tired and worn-out spirit of seasoned believers and faithful church members. For everyone, missions is a way for both giver and receiver to see God's love in action.

The Dover Baptist Association is partnering in 2024 to bring



together our churches for what we are dubbing "Operation Mission Swarm." Originally coined as a mission swarm by Pastor Jeff Mills to the Bruce Outreach Center in Westernport, Maryland (see info on page 2), there are a number of opportunities locally, regionally, nationally and internationally for churches to serve. 

- Maintain tables where we give out free Bibles, tracts, New Testaments, etc.
- Hand out flyers before races to advertise worship services and big celebration Sunday afternoon.
- Guide the fans around the track.
- Run games/matchbox car races, paint faces, & serve snow-cones and popcorn at our Kids Corner locations.
