STEPPING Plate UP TO THE

I'm the biggest baseball fan in the world...in October. The other months I seldom watch a game. There's something about Major League Baseball's World Series that changes my whole perspective on (the rest of) "America's favorite pastime." Admittedly, part of my handicap, as a baseball writer friend of mine explained, is that I don't fully understand the game. I don't fully comprehend the brilliance of the mental game combined with the incredible athletic prowess that gets teams to the Fall Classic. I watched pastors present big league dreams and share powerful stories of how God was working in their churches, missions and ministries. Our Dover Treasurer reported, how despite a downward trend in giving, God blessed the resources our churches gave. One of our pastors reported how Dover's support helped upgrade their day-school. He noted how doors were Divinely opened for dozens of kids from Richmond's highest at-risk neighborhoods. He said counselors saw a visible reduction of stress in children, as they were able to spend time in the safe space now provided by his church. He stressed how the giving of other Dover churches helped his church serve those in need.

Two churches reported that over 500 pastors and church leaders in Uganda, Africa were now being discipled and trained, in part, thanks to Dover's Partnership Mission and New Work Funds. Missions and Ministry partners shared how our Dover churches have helped them to be the hands, heart, feet and voice of Jesus in their communities, country and throughout the world.

As I've continued to watch the World Series, one thing is clear. It takes more than a few great players to win a world championship. The same is true for our association. It takes more than a few great churches and key leaders to make the most impact. We need a full roster of Dover church members. We need more volunteers in key positions. We need more giving to ministries making a difference. We need a greater presence at our key meetings to vote on important motions and/or the funding of vital ministries. 
