Reflecting on 10 Years

When I reflect on reaching my tenth anniversary serving Dover Baptist Association, the first word that comes to mind is adventure! Growing up in Georgia, I never learned about associations; I never really heard about Baptists doing much of anything together—church to church. My family and I went to a variety of Baptist churches, some with several thousand members, to perhaps barely one hundred.

Fast forward to when I was a junior in college. I began looking and thinking about seminaries. I strongly felt that God called me to Baptist Theological Seminary at Richmond. I did not know a soul in Virginia; believe it or not, I had never visited Richmond before! I just knew that was where God wanted me and that is where I went.

I enjoyed learning and obtaining new tools to explore the Bible and grew in my ability to teach others. My wife, Abbie, and I were engaged by the last year of seminary, where we had met. She began serving at Ridge Baptist Church, which led me to finding a job in the Richmond area too. I worked for an Information Technology company where I learned how to build websites. Dover, Middle District, and Richmond Associations were some of the clients. This was how I was first introduced to associations

Dover called me as their first Associate for Missions at the 2008 semiannual meeting, and I began working on May 1, 2008. Dover was celebrating its 225th anniversary that year, so I received a crash course in Dover's history! Richard Moore and Steve Allsbrook shared about their experiences leading Dover Baptists.

Throughout my ministry with Dover, I have had the opportunity to connect with a number of community organizations. I enjoy working with the wide array of volunteers and leaders from Dover churches. It is a joy and privilege to see a glimpse of the bigger picture of what God is doing in Metro Richmond and beyond.

I have had the opportunity to travel while serving Dover. I visited our partners in Macedonia twice (2014 and 2016) and our former Toronto Baptist partners in 2015. I was able to serve on a mission trip to Ecuador with several members of New Bethesda Baptist Church. I have made four trips to North and South Dakota, connecting with our partners at Tipi Wakan – Pete and Angela Adkins—and serving alongside at least seven Dover churches during WMUV's annual mission trip to Standing Rock.

An adventure indeed, one that I could never imagined. If I had been told while growing up in a small town in Georgia, that one day I would be celebrating ten years of ministry with a family of Baptists called Dover (in Virginia)—I would have thought the messenger was beyond crazy!

Thank you for allowing me to serve Dover. I look forward to having more adventures with you as we grow and serve together in the future!
