

Drop the Blanket!

Make sure you click on the "Merry Christmas Charlie Brown" link to enjoy a classic!

Songwriter Jason Soroski was watching the animated special *Merry Christmas Charlie Brown*, for the umpteenth time when he observed something previously unnoticed. In the scene when Charlie Brown's best friend Linus, recites Luke 2: 8-14, right when he says, "Fear not" (verse 10), he literally drops the one thing he holds most precious in the world – his security blanket.

Reflecting on the symbolism of Linus dropping the blanket, Soroski writes, "The birth of Jesus allows us to simply drop the false security we have been grasping so tightly and learn to trust and cling to Him instead."

As I re-read Luke's account, re-watched the cartoon clip, and reflected on Soroski's observation, it made me think how, even we Christians, tend to cling to the temporal things of this world. Whether it's our possessions, politics, position, personal well-being, etc., it's difficult for us to fully embrace the Word and Will of God when we're clinging to our own security blankets i.e., those things that give us a false sense of security and self.

In three scripture passages associated with the Christmas story (Luke 1:30, Matthew 1:20, and of course Luke 2:10) the angel of the Lord tells Mary, Joseph, and the shepherds to "Fear not!" In other words, "Drop the blanket Mary! What man says is impossible, God has spoken into existence." "Drop the blanket Joseph! Let go of your doubt, your reputation, your good standing in the community and know in all things God works for the good of those who love Him and who have been called according to His purpose." "Drop the blanket Shepherds (and any other laborers working the night shift)! Let go of the notion that you are somehow unworthy to receive God's favor because of your social status, your race, your age, your... (you fill in the blank) and know that God has a plan and purpose for your life." "Drop the blanket, people of God" Let go of your preconceived ideas and your tendency to put God in a box."

As we prepare our hearts and minds for Christmas, and the uncertainty of another year, let's resolve to "Drop the Blanket," and instead, cling tightly to the promises and certainty of God's Word and Will for our lives in Christ Jesus.
