**<u>Elect your Messengers!</u>** Article 4 of Dover's Constitution states: Each member church shall be entitled to send two messengers to Annual, Semiannual and special Called Association Meetings. A church that contributes at least \$400 to the General Fund during the Association's previous fiscal year shall be entitled to have three (3) messengers. An additional messenger is added for each additional \$400 contribution to the General Fund up to a maximum of seven (7) messengers for any church.

#### Reflection on Mission Possible 2018

On March 3, young adults from around the state joined together at Randolph-Macon College for Mission Possible, an annual one-day conference that focuses on discovering your calling through missions and art. The event was sponsored by various local non-profits and businesses who share in the common goal to reach young adults and inspire them to share their God-given talents.
