

Anxious for a New Beginning

In December I delivered the final thoughts that most people would hear about my mother as I officiated the celebration of her earthly life and eternal life with Jesus. In my remarks, I reported that my mother had been a founding member of Celebrate Recovery and an advocate for mental health, especially eliminating the stigma often associated with mental illness.

"In a time when society looked down on mental illness," I observed, "she never seemed ashamed of her struggles with anxiety and depression. She realized the first step to healing is admitting you need help, and the second step is to get it. If the statistics are accurate, 1 in every 3 of us are fighting that battle right now. I am, so let me encourage you. Honor my mother by reaching out and getting support. Don't fight that battle alone."

In his book, *Anxious for Nothing*, pastor, and best-selling author Max Lucado reports, "Anxiety-related issues are the number one mental health problem among women and are second only to alcohol and drug abuse among men."

Despite the relative calming of the qualms about politics and the pandemic, anxiety centered headlines still pervade the news. Another beloved celebrity who was seemingly full of joy, has taken his life. The UVA football team cancelled its remaining games to "heal" after the tragic shooting of three of their athletes. The world's once top tennis player and top gymnast are taking mental health sabbaticals while partnering with global brands to promote mental health awareness. The humanitarian and economic impact of war and greed and division is seen and felt daily by most of us. Negative angst-filled emotions have flared up over everything from prices at the pump to the prisoner swap with the Russians.

For the Christian, there is no mental health without spiritual health, and we are certainly not immune from the world's worries. For those of you who are anxious for a new beginning, I encourage you to pray, fast, open God's Word and your hearts to the counsel of the Holy Spirit. For those of you who are hurting, I beseech you to include the counsel of a Christian mental health professional. Please, don't fight that battle alone. God bless.

2023 Hepler Scholarship Applications Due by Wednesday, March 15, 2023

Who Can Apply for the Hepler Scholarship? I'm glad you asked.....

This scholarship fund is available to any person who is a member of a Dover Association Baptist church for at least one year prior to his/her application being submitted.

The application must be approved by the church.

The applicant must be planning to pursue a baccalaureate or graduate degree in an accredited college, university or seminary.

Seminary students must attend a college accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

The school may be denominational or non-denominational in Virginia or a Baptist institution out of state.

Applications are due on Wednesday, March 15, 2023.


